There are many reference types for citation in EndNote software. The difference type of the publication require difference information;

**Book**

- Author
- Year
- Title
- Edition (if any)
- Place Published
- Publisher

## Suggestions

### *Author name(s)*

- One author name per line
- Enter the author name with the first name, then the last name >> *Mark G. Robson* or enter the last name, then first name >> *Robson, Mark G.*
- Corporate author name must be entered with the following comma ( , ) >> *World Health Organization,* or *College of Public Health Sciences,, Chulalongkorn University*

### *Publication year*

- If there is no publication year, use >> *n.d.*

### *Publisher*

- If there is no place of publication, use >> *n.p.*

### *Page numbers*

- Enter just the page number >> *115-119* or *115-9* (Do not put the “page”, “p.”, or “pp.”)

### *Volume and issue number*

- Enter just the volume or issues. Do not put the “Vol.”, or “Issue/No.”

### *Edition*

- Enter the edition number of the book >> *1<sup>st</sup>*, *2<sup>nd</sup>*, or *3<sup>rd</sup>*, then the EndNote will be add “ed.” automatically
